

LIVE AND LOCAL

CALL FOR WORKING GROUP MEMBERS

Live and Local is a capacity building project which will focus on strengthening and supporting local live music communities including musicians, businesses and venues, local councils and local industry workers across Gympie, Noosa, Sunshine Coast and Moreton Bay.

This cross-regional project will support:

- development of local area Music Working Groups
- mentorship of emerging event curators
- performance opportunities for new and emerging musicians
- support of local venue-based live music industry
- delivery of live music events as part of a region wide micro-festival
- skills and professional development workshops
- local and regional industry roundtables
- foster a consistent approach to building a sustainable live music industry in our region
- build support for future projects based on the experience, engagement and information gained through the program

We are seeking industry representatives to join Working Groups including:

- Emerging and established musicians
- Music businesses and professionals (eg: recording studios, tech hire companies, music teachers)
- Live music venue, event and festival organisers
- Other venues and festivals with an interest to include music into their places and spaces
- Local government representatives
- Local community leaders

Purpose: To establish a diverse group of community members who can work together to support the growth of the live music scene in their local area.

Role: Working Group members will provide guidance and insight into delivery of micro-festival events; professional development needs and ways that project partners can support local long-term development of the music sector.

Responsibilities:

- Attend fortnightly online project meetings to provide input into the Live and Local project (May - July)
- Provide relevant information to assist with conducting a live music census
- Provide ideas and insight about delivery of micro-festival events
- Provide ideas and insight about the professional development needs of the local live music community
- Take part in local industry forum in your local area (dates TBC)
- Help to promote opportunities and events that are part of the Live and Local program
- Where possible, attend local events and programs
- Take part in project evaluation
